

ORDINANCE NO. 362

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF HARTLEY, IOWA 2016 MUNICIPAL
CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 70 TRAFFIC CODE
ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES, SECTION 70.03 PARKING VIOLATIONS:
ALTERNATE**

WHEREAS, The City Council has defined certain parking violations within the city; and

Be It Enacted by the City Council of the City of Hartley, Iowa:

SECTION AMENDED: Chapter 70, Traffic Code Enforcement Procedures, Section 70.03 Parking Violations: Alternate, is Amended to read as follows:

Uncontested violations of parking restrictions imposed by the Code of Ordinances shall be charged upon a simple notice of a fine payable at the office of the City Clerk. The simple notice of a fine shall be in the amount of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for all violations except the following violations under the Hartley Traffic Code: during snow removal operations under Section 69.13, snow route parking violations under Section 69.14, and improper use of a persons with disabilities parking permit under Section 69.07(2). If such fine is not paid within thirty (30) days, it shall be increased by five dollars (\$5.00). The simple notice of a fine for snow removal operations violations under Section 69.13 and snow route parking violations under Section 69.14 is fifty dollars (\$50.00). The simple notice of a fine for improper use of a persons with disabilities parking permit under Section 69.07(2) is two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
